The Friends of Kinder Farm Park Meeting

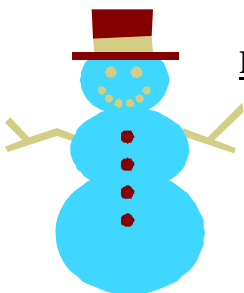
